The scale of domestic abuse across the St Helens borough cannot be underestimated. There were **3,745** reports of domestic abuse in **2023/24**. This is a reduction from the number of incidents in the previous year **2022/23** of **4,706** but it remains at a very high level. For this reason, Domestic Abuse remains one of the priorities for St Helens.

Domestic abuse takes multiple forms and is commonly characterised by a pattern of controlling and coercive behaviour. It disproportionately affects women, but anyone can be impacted including children and young people.

Our overarching vision is:

"WORKING TOGETHER TO PREVENT AND REDUCE THE HARM CAUSED BY DOMESTIC ABUSE WHILST ADDRESSING THE UNDERLYING ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIOURS THAT PERPETUATE IT."
