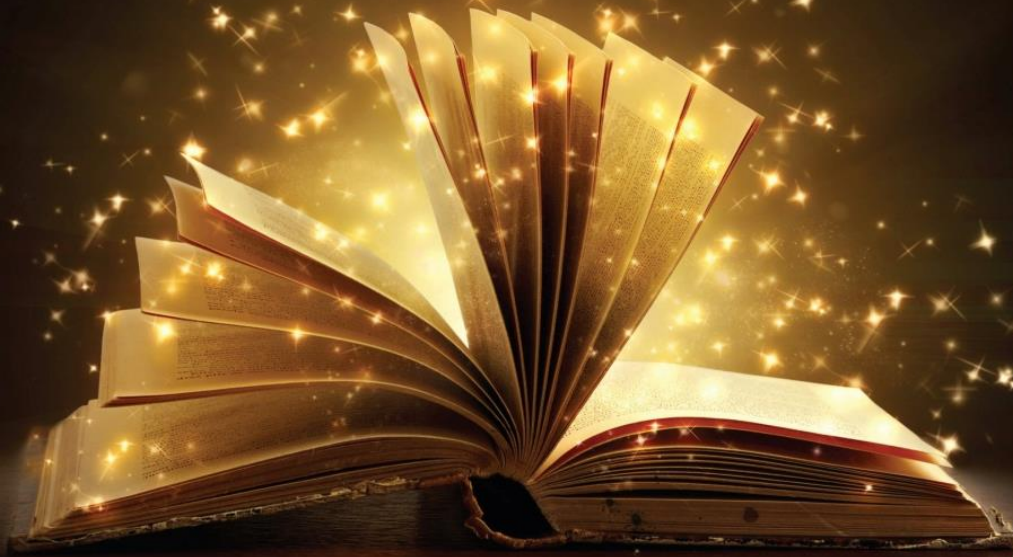




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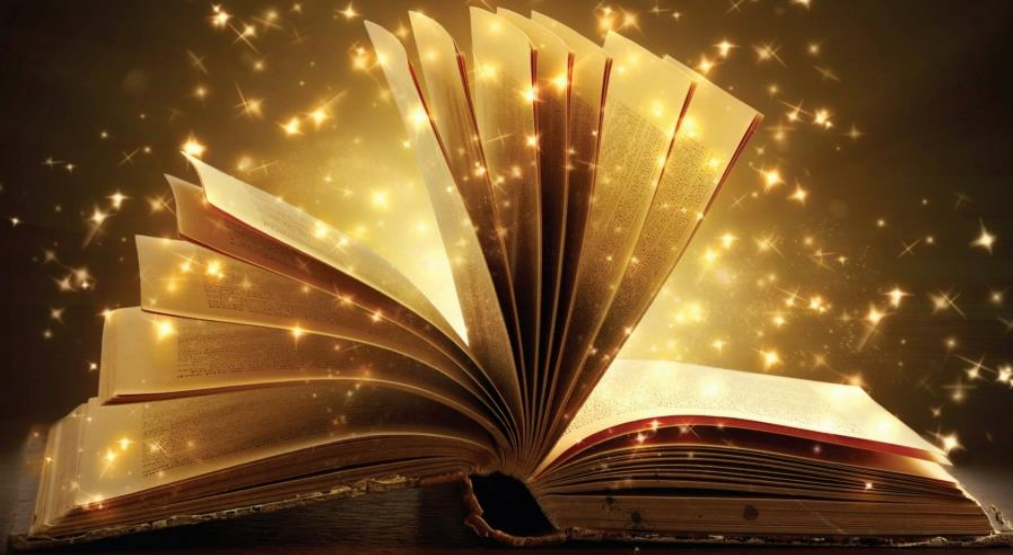

Some resources, particularly certain class set titles are very popular, so we advise reserving in advance to avoid disappointment.

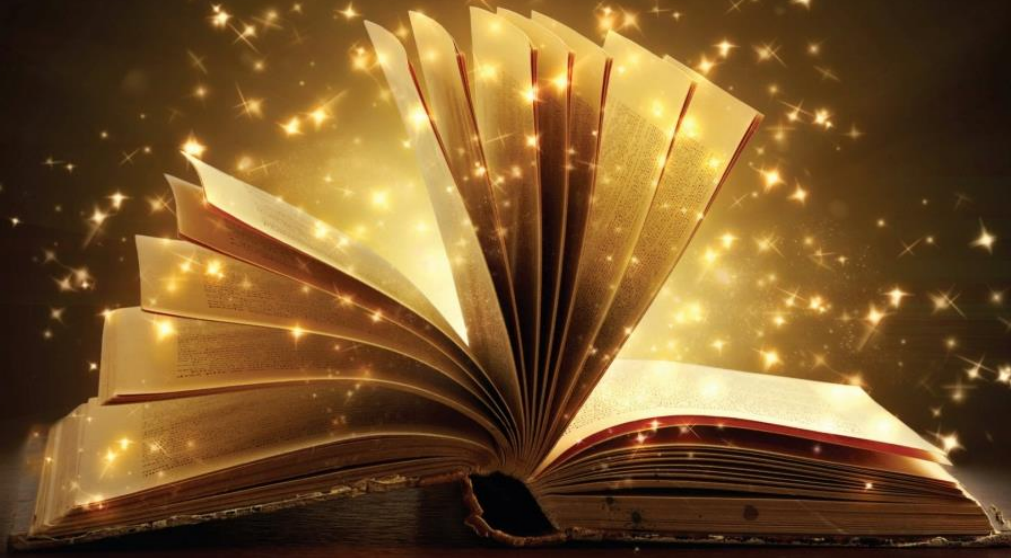
