

Primary Schools Arts and Culture Offer 2021/2022

One full day, in-house creative workshop (Art, Drama, Music, Dance)

Choose from our range of quality assured practitioners to deliver a full day of creative workshops. A workshop day can accommodate between 15 and 60 students in total, depending on the art form. There is also the option of a 1-hour family session after school, when the students can work creatively with their parents/carers. Additional workshops days can also be purchased, as detailed overleaf.



Access to a programme of CPD opportunities in each art form

In September 2021, we will release a calendar of CPD events for teachers and school staff. Schools can access as many of these opportunities as they would like and can book up to 5 places per session, subject to availability. The sessions will be delivered by experts in the arts and creative education.



Cultural Visits

We will provide transport up to the value of £300 to regional arts and cultural venues, and support with the planning of content for the visit. Where there is a charge for tickets, we may be able to negotiate a discounted rate. Once schools have used this allocation, they can continue to book their arts and cultural transport through Cultured to benefit from our reduced rates.

Creative Industries Careers Event

Schools will be invited to bring up to 30 students to a town centre careers event in the summer term, providing the students with information about careers in the Creative Industries.



Networking Opportunities & access to support

We will continue to facilitate the Primary Arts Network, helping primary Arts co-ordinators to share best practice. Each school will be able to contact the Development Officer for general guidance or assistance in the planning and delivery of their Arts and Cultural offer. They will also be supported in terms of their Artsmark journey by engaging in the activities listed above.

Additional Services

Art and Design curriculum planning support

We assist schools in the planning and delivery of their Art and Design curriculum by creating an overview of skill progression in the subject and a series of bespoke and detailed knowledge plans for each year group. Ideally this support is delivered over 3 full days in school, however, individual school needs can be established through an initial consultation and the level of support agreed in advance. Art and Design Curriculum Delivery

If you have a specific skill to deliver through art lessons but do not have the expertise, we can arrange for an artist to deliver the sessions for you. As well as introducing your students to a practicing artist, the lessons will also serve as CPD for your staff so that they feel confident to deliver in future. Unlike our practitioner workshops, these sessions focus on specific skills identified by the school and not on the artist's own practice. The cost includes preparation time but does not include materials.

In-house workshop

Additional workshop days can be purchased as a way of extending the time you have with a practitioner. Alternatively, they can be used to introduce your students to a different artform. The cost includes all preparation time and materials.

Extended curriculum delivery, Arts Week and Whole School Projects

We plan units of work and whole school projects, which can involve multiple practitioners. These are developed through consultation with schools and so differ in price. Please contact Evonne Bixter for more information.

In-House CPD for all staff (2 hours)

Any of the sessions on our CPD calendar can be delivered in-house if a school would like their whole staff team to attend. We can also plan bespoke sessions focusing on a particular skill or topic.

Individual CPD place -

Schools who subscribe to our offer can access up to 5 places per CPD session. If additional places are needed, these can be purchased at additional cost. **Artsmark schools get two places for the price of one.**
