The **Wild World Heroes** are coming to a library near you! With a focus on nature, this year's **Summer Reading Challenge** teams up with The World Wildlife Fund, the world's leading independent conservation organization.

Produced by The Reading Agency, the Summer Reading Challenge celebrates reading, nature and action for the environment and encourages children aged 4-11 to challenge themselves to read 6 library books over the summer, preventing the summer reading 'dip'. As they read their six books, children collect stickers and after completing the challenge, they will receive a certificate and medal.

Children who join the Wild World Heroes will learn how they can help their environment and be inspired to stand up for our planet. St Helens Library Service has a wide range of awesome books and eBooks to help children complete the challenge, as well as a packed programme of fun, free events and activities over the summer, which includes lots of ideas for taking care of our planet.

The Summer Reading Challenge keeps children reading over the summer break, building skills and confidence and celebrating Reading for Pleasure. It is open to all children, free of charge.
