CITATION: Ancient semi natural woodland on the steep banks of a stream. The woodland is dominated by oak and supports a rich ground and bryophyte flora including a large number of locally rare species and extensive carpets of Bluebells. The woodland is an important breeding bird site.

APPRAISAL: This site has been evaluated against the guidelines approved by the Council for selection of Local Sites. The site's evaluation against the guidelines is set out below.

SUMMARY: The combination of these factors has led to this site being identified as a Local Site.

NOTE: Validated data from 1981 to December 2003 have been used in this assessment. Other data may become available to support this designation.

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
