The service will be available to issue emergency funeral documents on call Saturday 24th December (10-4pm), Sunday 25th December & Monday 26th December (10-12 noon) also, Saturday 31st December (10-4pm), Sunday 1st & Monday 2nd January (10-12 noon) on 01744 676728 and will also be available for enquiries regarding Registrar General Licence weddings/civil partnerships throughout the Christmas and New Year period. All registrations are by appointment only, we accept card payments only for certificates.

Number of expected visitors to the Cemetery & Crematorium

Dear Funeral Directors, Officiants, Clergy & Colleagues,

Just a reminder as the busy winter season is now upon us and to help funeral services run smoothly and professionally and to assist the bereaved at an already difficult time, please note the following: -

- Please let us know if funerals are going to be large attendance at the time of booking your funeral this ensures we have enough staff available to assist with traffic direction and parking provision.
- Please make sure that your paperwork in on time (Cremation paperwork must be in 2 working days prior to the cremation by 9.30am and burial paperwork must be in 3 working days prior to the funeral by 10am), please also take into consideration any bank holiday dates, late paperwork causes operational problem and it may delay the funeral if a problem is identified with the paperwork.
- Please make sure all paperwork is legible, fully completed and correct, burial paperwork to also include all coffin sizes not to be sent separately on an email.
- Invoices must be paid in full within one week of receipt, we do encourage you to make a BACS payment or card payment for this, please do not rely on the team to chase outstanding invoices.
- We recommend only three pieces of music in any single slot, 5 minutes in and 5 minutes out and 20 minutes for the service, any more pieces of music we encourage a double slot.
- Please do not pull the curtains open to retrieve flowers as this causes damage to the automatic track and any expense incurred will be passed on to the Funeral Director, if the curtains are damaged and become out of operation some funerals will no longer be able to have the curtains closed which would cause distress to them. We have noticed this happening a lot recently.
- Please can you ask Funeral Directors to assist mourners leaving through both doors, to keep the flow through chapel going smoothly as we want to keep funerals running on time, especially with more funerals now being webcast live. This benefits everyone during the busy time.
- Please make sure you arrive on time for funerals, so not to disrupt other services, please also do not arrive too early, as this can make the wait to enter chapel seem longer.
- Can Officiants and Ministers please use the lectern when carrying out the service as if you stand away from the lectern and the service is being webcast, the eulogy will not be heard or be audible if recorded and if the bereaved family has requested a keepsake or re-watch of the video then the service and eulogy will not be available.
- Do not place any items in the coffin such as glass, pottery, metal frames, cat litter, a set of cremated remains, cans, paper, etc as per our 'Instruction for cremation' ask if you are unsure and we can help. Items of this kind can cause damage to the two-cremator refractory and hearth and items such as this are not only harmful to the environment, but they also cause damage to the brickwork and the safety of the staff.
