Assisted Travel to School Form Application Form



This application form should be used for all applications for assistance with travel to school for the 2017/2018 school year.

Only applications received from households who pay their Council Tax to St.Helens Council will be processed.

For more information about who is eligible for assisted travel, please refer to the leaflet which accompanies this form. If you are entitled, assistance will usually be in the form of a public service bus pass.

All applications must include a passport-size photograph of the pupil with their name and date of birth printed on the back.

Notification of changes

Please note that if your child changes address, changes/leaves school or is absent from school for more than 4 weeks, it is essential that the bus pass is returned immediately and a receipt must be obtained as proof of return. Failure to do so will result in you being invoiced for the cost of the bus pass, from the date your child becomes no longer eligible for assistance to the date the bus pass is returned to this office.

School details

a) Primary-age pupils

Assistance with transport will usually be provided to those pupils who are attending their nearest qualifying school with available places, where the safest measured walking distance between home and school is 2 miles or more for students under 8 years and 3 miles or more for students aged 8 years and over.

b) Secondary-age pupils

Assistance with transport will usually be provided to those pupils who are attending their nearest qualifying school with available places, where the measured walking distance between home and school is more than 3 miles.

Low-income criteria

a) Primary-age pupils - aged up to 11 years

Those pupils who are entitled to free school meals, or whose families are in receipt of the maximum Working Tax Credit, will be awarded assistance with transport if they are attending their nearest suitable school where the measured walking distance is more than two miles from home.

b) Secondary-age pupils

Those pupils who are entitled to free school meals, or whose families are in receipt of the maximum Working Tax Credit, will be entitled to assistance with transport if the pupil is attending any of the 3 nearest suitable secondary

schools (not faith schools) closest to their home, providing the measured walking distance to these schools are more than 2 miles and less than 6 miles.

c) Religion or beliefs

If a parent expresses a preference for a school on the grounds of religion or belief, then a pupil aged 11-16 will be entitled to assistance if it is the nearest suitable school and the distance is more than 2 miles but not more than 15 miles. Proof of low income - either Entitlement to Free School Meals or maximum Working Tax Credit (Part 2 of the HM Revenue & Customs letter) must be provided at the time of application.

d) Change in circumstances

If there is a change in circumstances, and the pupil is in year 10 or year 11 and is a St.Helens resident, they may be entitled to assistance with transport if the school they are attending is more than 3 miles from their home address and an application for transport has not been previously received.

The Department of Education states a qualifying school is a school that provides education appropriate to the age, ability and aptitude of the child. The measured walking route is one that an accompanied child may walk.
